
# CHILD CARE TRAINING

Level 1: Intro to Childcare the initial 40 hours.

Levels 2, 3, and 4 Courses must be taken through the Green Apple Training Portal.

## Level 2: Florida Child Care Professional Credential (FCCPC)

Level 2 focuses on the competencies required by the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) for early childhood professionals seeking a Florida staff credential.

The program addresses the skills and knowledge early childhood professionals should strive for when working with young children. The program is composed of 120 hours of online coursework; personal and professional written reflections; a classroom observation to document teaching proficiency; a professional resources portfolio; and a comprehensive exam.
